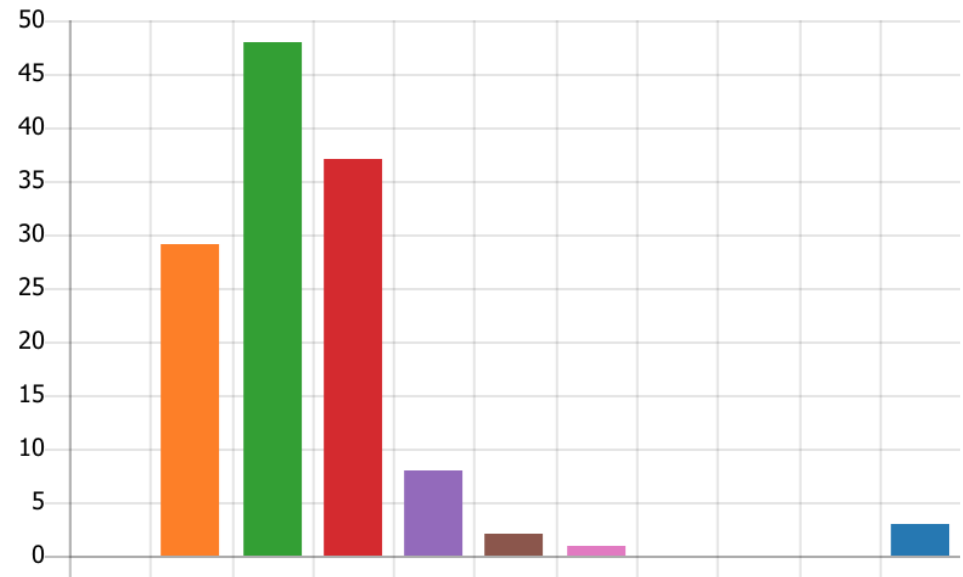
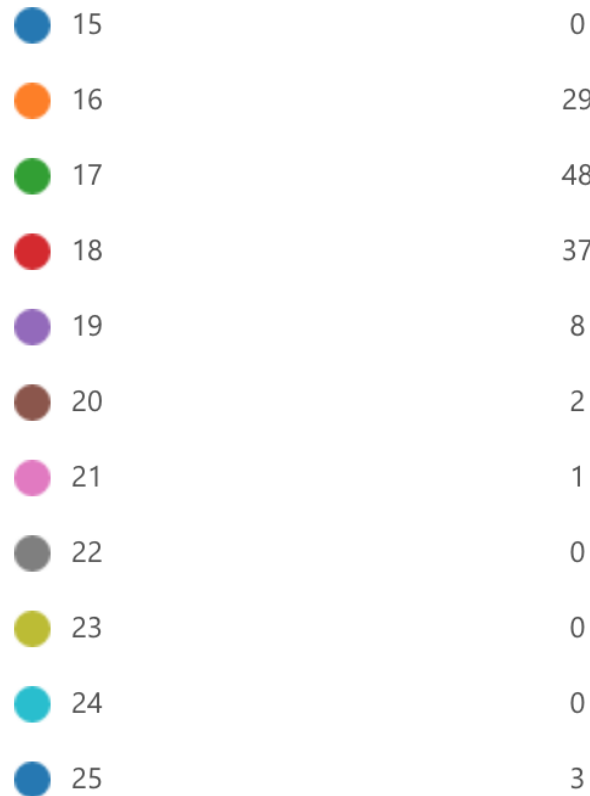

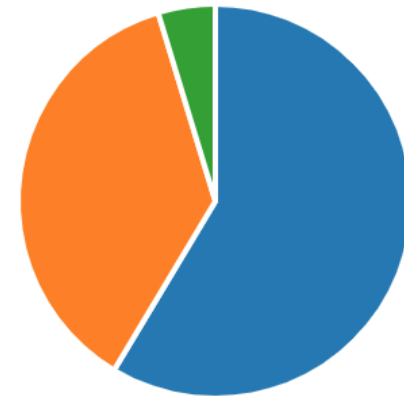
1. How old are you?

2. What is your gender?

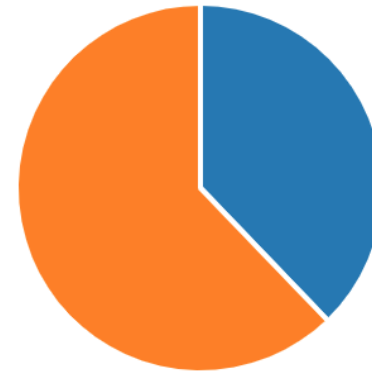

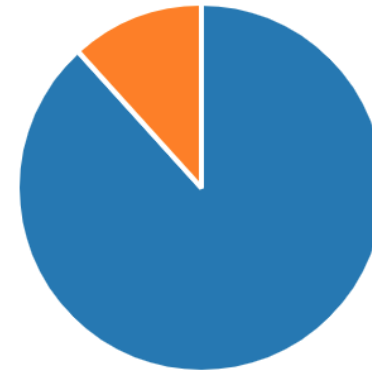

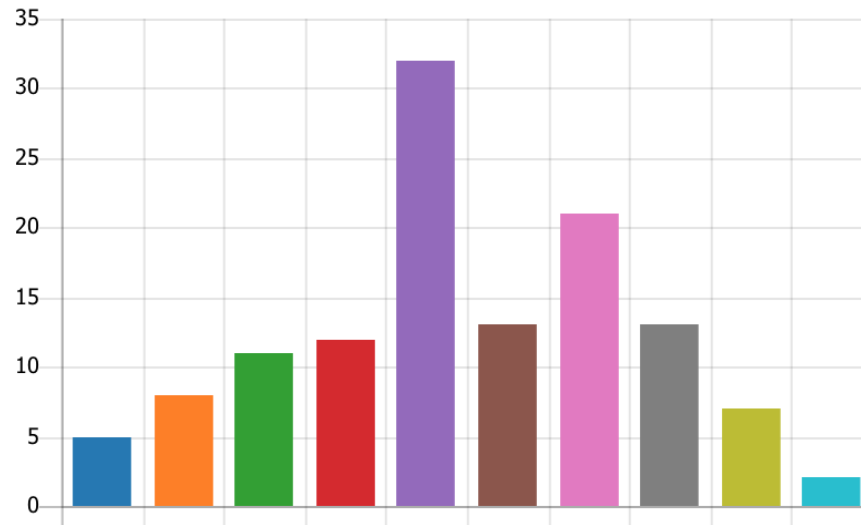

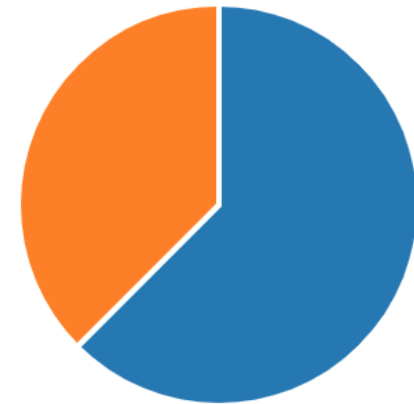

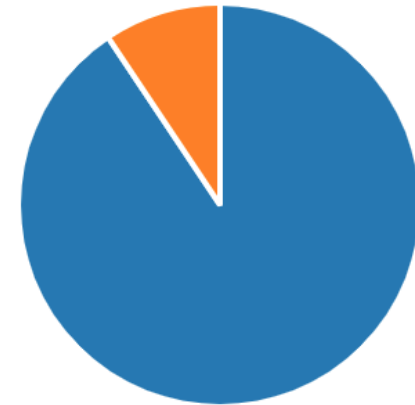
8. Would a trip from your school to a job information centre help you?

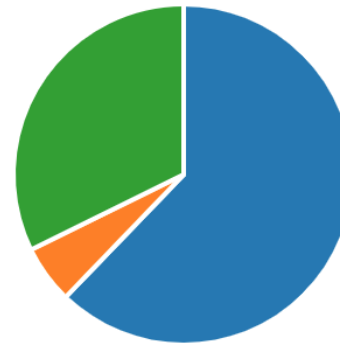

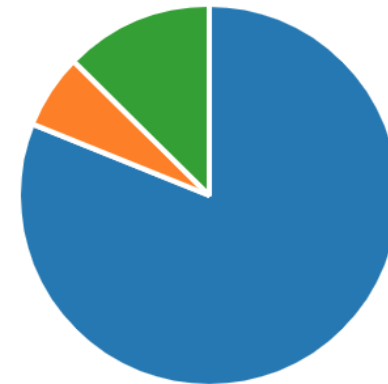

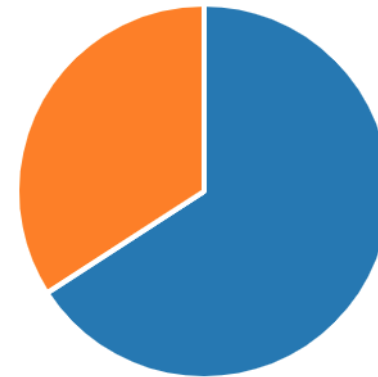

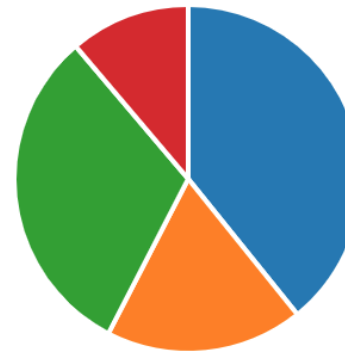

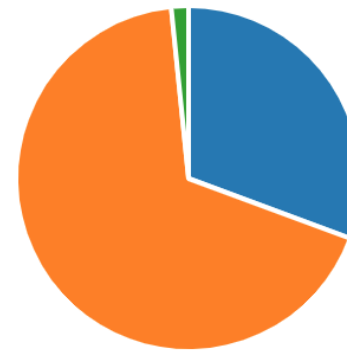

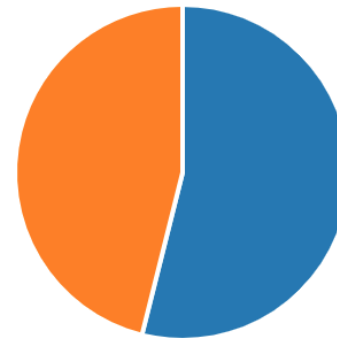

9. How often do you use the following career consulting tools at your school: public authority



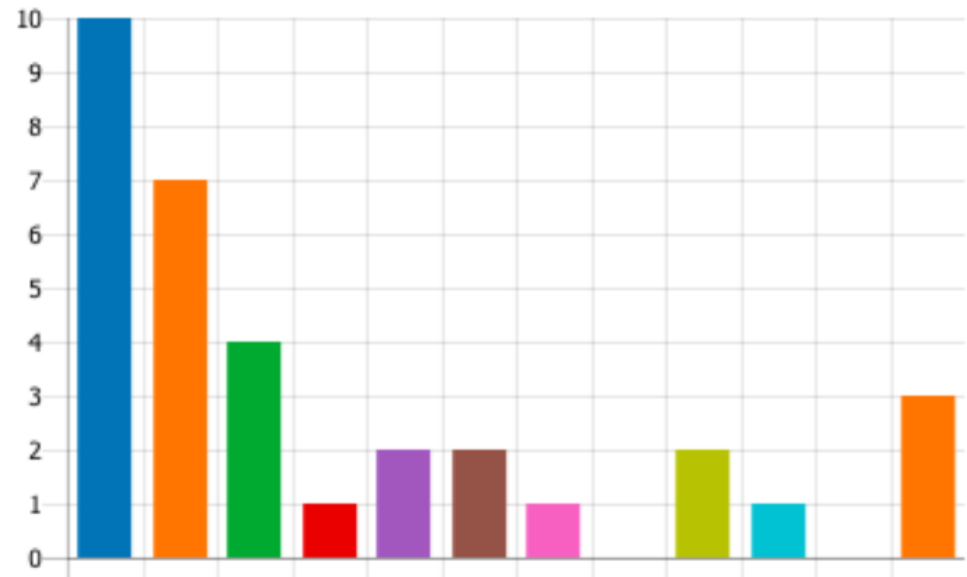

10. How often do you use the following career consulting tools at your school: social workers



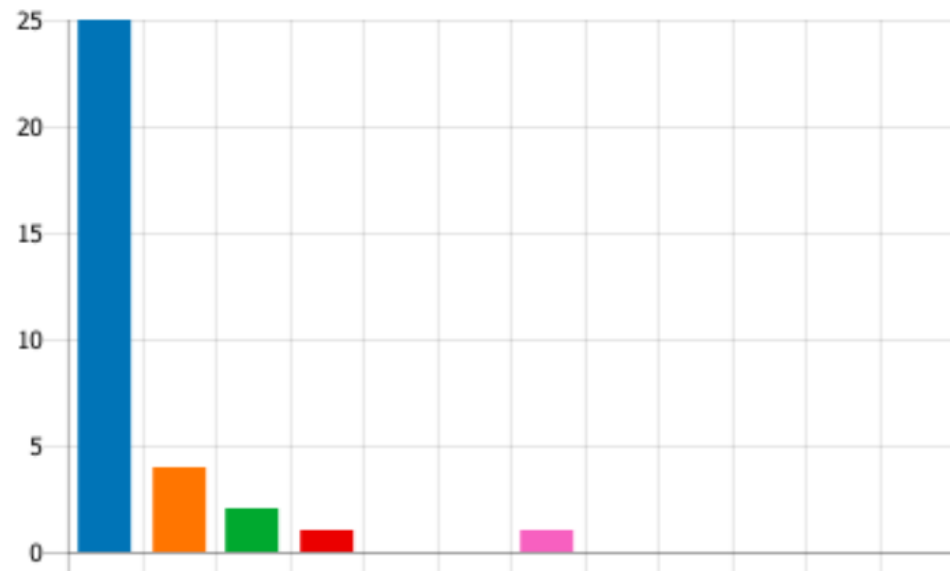
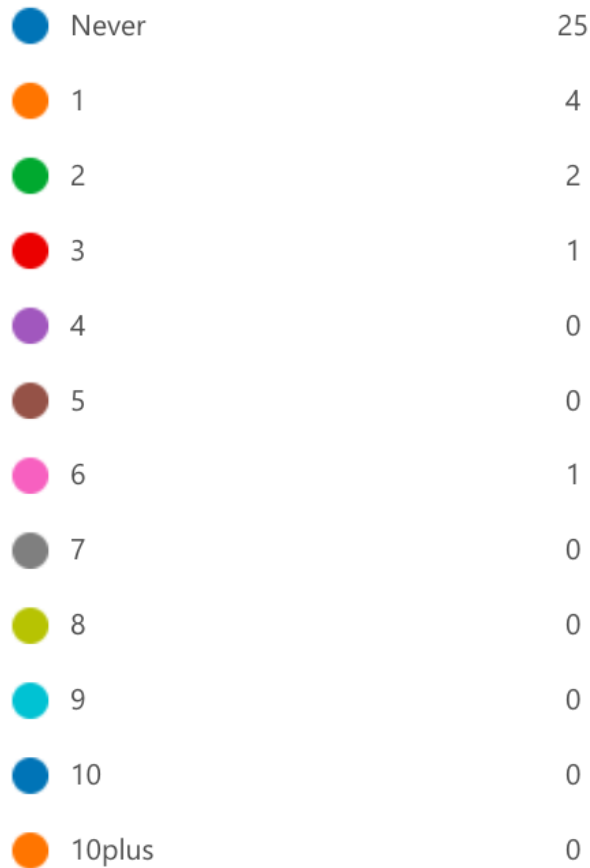

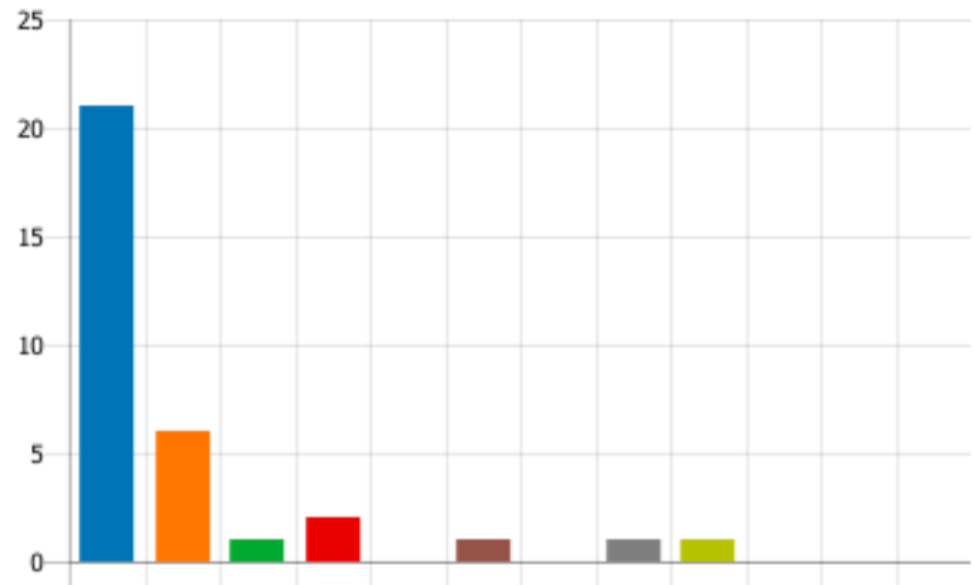

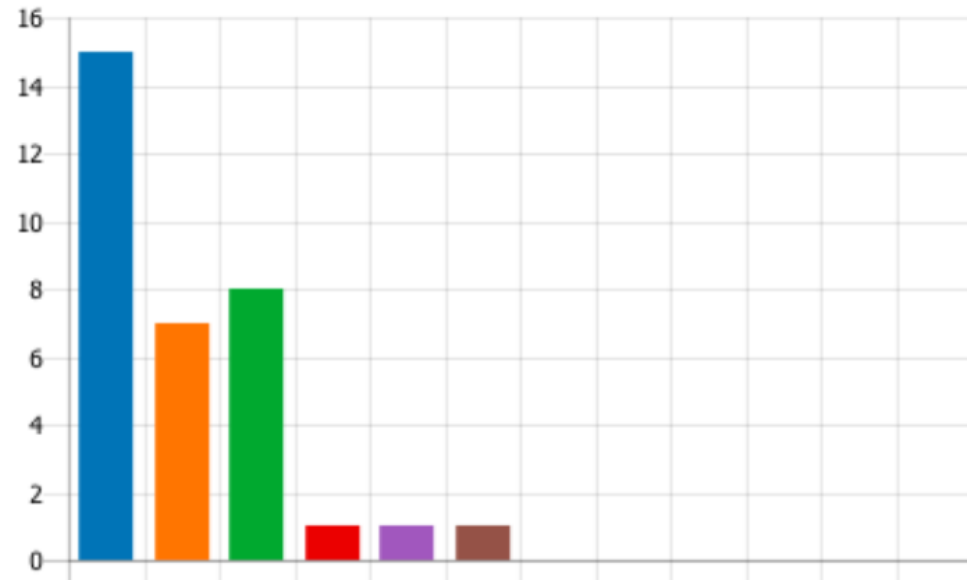
