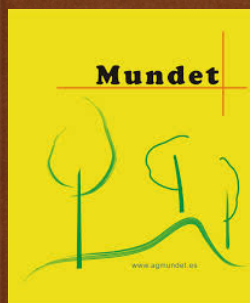

# PUBLIC SCHOOLS

- Kindergartens (0 - 3 y.o.)
- Primary Schools (3 - 12 y.o.)
- Secondary Schools: just compulsory studies (12 - 16 y.o.) / compulsory studies + Highschool (16 - 18 y.o.) / compulsory studies + Highschool + VET / Highschool + VET / VET (16 - x y.o.)
- University (18 - x y.o.)

## Characteristics

- They are completely under the Education Department
- Teachers are public workers
- They offer free education to any kind of students for compulsory studies and offer lower prices for the other educational stages
- Living in the same district as the school is a must to get in

## Characteristics

- They have to follow the Education Program of the region they are located or in case they are an international school, follow the program of that country
- Teachers are Private workers, they are contracted by the school

# NON COMPULSORY EDUCATION STAGES

- **High school** just prepares for higher studies (University or High VET), this studies are theoretical ones.
- **Medium VET:** practical studies focused on one family which prepare students for labor market as technicians. Once finished they can access to a High VET related training too. To get the degree students must complete a stage in an enterprise. It is the school which makes the contact with the enterprises (even in Dual system).
- **High VET:** practical studies focused on one family which prepare students for labor market as high technicians. Once finished they can access to University. To get the degree students must complete a stage in an enterprise. It is the school which makes the contact with the enterprises (even in Dual System).





# EDUCATIONAL ORIENTATION AND CAREER GUIDANCE

- Tutors

- Specific subjects (Formation and Labor Orientation, Entrepreneurial and Enterprise), both compulsory at VET studies
