A <u>SWOT analysis for schools</u> is a tool that can provide prompts to the governors, management teachers and staff involved in the analysis of what is effective and less effective in the schools systems and procedures. Often used in preparation for a plan of some form (that could be an audit, assessments, quality checks etc.).

Strengths – Factors that are likely to have a positive effect on (or be an enabler to) achieving the school's objectives

Weaknesses – Factors that are likely to have a negative effect on (or be a barrier to) achieving the school's objectives

Opportunities – External Factors that are likely to have a positive effect on achieving or exceeding the school's objectives, or goals not previously considered

Threats – External Factors and conditions that are likely to have a negative effect on achieving the school's objectives, or making the the objective redundant or un-achievable.

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WEAKNESSES

- Student's command of foreign languages
- Too large foreign language classes.

- Some of the teachers are unmotivated, and careless.
- We hardly ever get talked about how to get a job
- There are many students per class. Teachers sometimes can not attend all of them

Proposals for improvement

- Anonymity
- Divide the class into two groups, one with the tutor and the other with the counselor.

- Do some tutorials outdoors.
